

GENERAL:

- A. This Addendum modifies or amends the South Florida Regional Intermodal Logistics Center Request for Proposals (RFP) dated July 10, 2009 and other previous Addenda. This Addendum shall become a part of the RFP. Capitalized terms used in this Addendum and not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings set forth in the RFP.

- B. Each Respondent shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the transmittal letter to its Proposal. Failure to do so may be cause for disqualification of Proposal.

ADDENDUM ITEM:

Question 1: For each of the South Florida Ports, please show the current calendar year TEU volumes through October, 2009 with projections for the remainder of the year, with said volumes by national source of origin.

Response: Attached as Appendix A is a spreadsheet entitled “The ILC Top 50 Import Countries.” Appendix A reflects the amount of cargo carrying TEUs (no empties) for the Port of Miami and Port Everglades. This data information was generated and obtained from the Piers reports based on the cargo passing through each port. Currently, the Port of Palm Beach imported containers is minimal since we mainly export cargo to the Caribbean region. Of the minimal imported cargo through the Port of Palm Beach, the TEUs are mainly imported from Canada, Bahamas (Freeport) and Dominican Republic.

Question 2: For each of the South Florida Ports, please show projected TEUs for the years 2015, 2020, and 2025, with said volumes broken down by national source of origin.

Response: It is difficult to predict the future. One method of forecasting for the future is to analyze the historical data and based on that data apply a growth rate for the future projections. The sponsor has attached as Appendix B a spreadsheet entitled “Container Traffic North America 1990-2008”, for the Respondents’ use. The spreadsheet depicts the historical container traffic passing through each port in North America. This information was obtained from the American Association of Port

Authorities website. The future projections for the remainder of 2009, 2015, 2020 and 2025 are not provided or available, but an estimated annual growth rate of 2% to 3% is predicted for the South Florida Region.

Question 3: For each of the South Florida Ports, please show the number of TEUs by shipping company.

Response: The information requested for the TEUs by shipping company from the Ports of Miami and Everglades is currently not available. It is estimated that the Port of Palm Beach's largest tenant, Tropical Shipping, is responsible for 98% of the Port's TEUs. Additional information has been requested from the Port of Miami and Port Everglades. The information will be forwarded to the Respondents when received.

Question 4: For the Port of Miami, please provide information as to the number of TEUs which will be redirected to the Hialeah facility, and whether those TEUs will be handled by rail directly from the Port to the Hialeah facility or by truck to the Hialeah facility.

Response: The requested information has been requested from the Port of Miami. The information will be forwarded to the Respondents when received.

Question 5: Given the sensitive nature of the business plan materials, we are requesting that all information provided by Respondent to the Sponsor in response to Addendum No. 7 of the RFP be kept confidential. Please confirm whether this request is possible.

Response: As indicated in Section 5.9 of the RFP, certain financial information (Section 119.071(1)(c), Florida Statutes) and certain trade secret information (Section 815.045, Florida Statutes) are exempt from disclosure to third parties. If a Respondent believes that portions of its Proposal are exempt from disclosure to third parties, the Respondent shall clearly label the specific portions sought to be kept confidential as "CONFIDENTIAL PROPRIETARY INFORMATION" and shall specify the exemption that the Respondent is relying upon. Although the Sponsor does not intend to publicize the Proposals and other information provided by any Respondent, pursuant to Florida's Public Records Act, the Sponsor may be required to publicly disclose to

third parties any Proposals and materials submitted by Respondents if third parties make a public records request for such materials. The Sponsor shall use commercially reasonable efforts to notify the affected Respondent of any public records request relating to information or materials marked as confidential by the Respondent, and the Respondent shall be responsible for defending its basis for claiming an exemption from disclosure under Applicable Law. The Sponsor asks that each Respondent carefully consider the level of proprietary information that it includes in its response to the Sponsor's request for additional information and the exemptions available to protect such information from public disclosure.
