

GENERAL:

- A. This Addendum modifies, changes from or adds to the South Florida Regional Intermodal Logistics Center Request for Proposals (RFP) dated July 10, 2009 and other previous Addenda. This Addendum shall become a part of the RFP. Capitalized terms used in this Addendum and not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings set forth in the RFP.

- B. Each Respondent shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the transmittal letter to its Proposal. Failure to do so may be cause for disqualification of Proposal.

ADDENDUM ITEM:

Question 1: We are interested in responding to the RFP for the South Florida Regional Intermodal Logistics Center. We did not submit a response to the Request for Qualification but would of course submit this documentation along with our RFP submission. Is there anything that would prevent us from submitting a response to the RFP?

Response 1: Pursuant to Section 1.2 of the RFP, the Sponsor has only solicited Proposals from the Pre-Qualified Respondents. The RFP does not prohibit unsolicited parties from submitting a response to the RFP. In connection with the receipt of a Proposal from an unsolicited party, the Sponsor reserves all of the rights set forth in Section 5.4 of the RFP.

Question 2: Please explain why entities that were pre-qualified together under the RFQ can submit separate responses to the RFP.

Response 2: Pursuant to Section 5.10 of the RFP, a Respondent may make any changes deemed appropriate to the organizational structure identified in the response to the RFQ so long as at least one member of each Pre-Qualified Respondent remains a member of the Respondent's team. The RFP does not prohibit Pre-Qualified Respondents that are no longer working jointly from submitting separate Proposals. If any such Proposal does not satisfy the minimum requirements of the RFP, the Proposal may be deemed non-responsive by the Sponsor.
